SICILY GRAND TOUR

FROM THE HISTORIC STREETS OF PALERMO TO THE SEASIDE CHARM OF CEFALÙ, FROM THE GREEK HERITAGE OF SEGESTA TO THE VINEYARDS OF MARSALA, THE JOURNEY CONTINUES TO THE MAJESTIC TEMPLES OF AGRIGENTO, THE REMARKABLE ROMAN MOSAICS OF PIAZZA ARMERINA, THE VIBRANT CULTURE OF CATANIA, THE VOLCANIC LANDSCAPES OF MOUNT ETNA, AND FINALLY THE TIMELESS ELEGANCE OF TAORMINA.

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PALERMO – CROSSROADS OF CIVILIZATIONS

THE JOURNEY BEGINS IN PALERMO, A CITY WHERE ARAB, NORMAN AND BAROQUE INFLUENCES COEXIST IN A FASCINATING CULTURAL MOSAIC. HISTORIC MARKETS, ORNATE CHURCHES AND NOBLE PALACES REVEAL CENTURIES OF HISTORY SHAPED BY THE MEDITERRANEAN WORLD.

CEFALÙ – A SEASIDE JEWEL

MOVING EAST ALONG THE COAST, CEFALÙ OFFERS ONE OF SICILY'S MOST CHARMING SEASIDE SETTINGS. ITS NORMAN CATHEDRAL AND PICTURESQUE STREETS LIE BENEATH A DRAMATIC ROCKY PROMONTORY OVERLOOKING THE SEA.

SEGESTA – ECHOES OF ANCIENT GREECE

IN THE HILLS OF WESTERN SICILY, SEGESTA REVEALS ONE OF THE ISLAND'S MOST IMPRESSIVE GREEK TEMPLES. STANDING IN QUIET ISOLATION AMONG ROLLING LANDSCAPES, THE TEMPLE REFLECTS THE GRANDEUR OF SICILY'S CLASSICAL PAST.

MARSALA – WINE AND SEA

MARSALA INTRODUCES THE RICH WINE TRADITIONS OF WESTERN SICILY. HISTORIC CELLARS AND VINEYARDS NEAR THE SEA TELL THE STORY OF THE FAMOUS FORTIFIED WINE THAT CARRIES THE TOWN'S NAME.

AGRIGENTO – THE VALLEY OF THE TEMPLES

THE JOURNEY CONTINUES TO AGRIGENTO, HOME TO THE EXTRAORDINARY VALLEY OF THE TEMPLES, ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES IN THE MEDITERRANEAN. MAJESTIC GREEK TEMPLES RISE ABOVE THE LANDSCAPE, EVOKING THE GRANDEUR OF ANCIENT AKRAGAS.

PIAZZA ARMERINA – THE ART OF ROMAN MOSAICS

INLAND, PIAZZA ARMERINA REVEALS THE SPECTACULAR VILLA ROMANA DEL CASALE, FAMOUS FOR ITS REMARKABLY PRESERVED ROMAN MOSAICS DEPICTING SCENES OF DAILY LIFE, MYTHOLOGY AND HUNTING.

CATANIA – LAVA STONE AND STREET FOOD

ON THE EASTERN COAST, CATANIA WELCOMES VISITORS WITH LIVELY STREETS AND BAROQUE ARCHITECTURE BUILT FROM VOLCANIC STONE. THE CITY IS ALSO CELEBRATED FOR ITS VIBRANT STREET FOOD CULTURE, WHERE MARKETS AND TRADITIONAL DISHES EXPRESS THE BOLD FLAVORS OF SICILIAN CUISINE.

MOUNT ETNA – THE MOUNTAIN OF FIRE

DOMINATING THE LANDSCAPE, MOUNT ETNA OFFERS A DRAMATIC NATURAL ENVIRONMENT OF LAVA FIELDS, FORESTS AND VOLCANIC CRATERS. AN EXCURSION ON EUROPE'S HIGHEST ACTIVE VOLCANO REVEALS BREATHTAKING VIEWS AND UNIQUE GEOLOGICAL FORMATIONS, FOLLOWED BY A WINE TASTING ON THE FERTILE VOLCANIC SLOPES.

TAORMINA – THE TERRACE OF SICILY

THE JOURNEY CONCLUDES IN TAORMINA, PERCHED ABOVE THE IONIAN SEA. THE ANCIENT GREEK THEATRE OFFERS ONE OF THE MOST ICONIC PANORAMAS IN ITALY, WITH MOUNT ETNA RISING MAJESTICALLY IN THE BACKGROUND.
